Congrats Beija

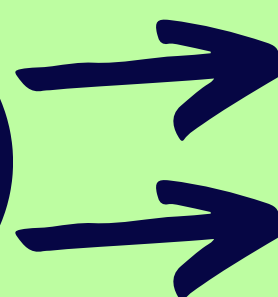
