**The holiday, Mother's day, was first put into action by a lady named Ann Jarvis. She established a holiday called "Mother's Friendship Day" after the civil war. The holiday was meant to bring mothers from both sides of the conflict together.**

Anna Jarvis (Ann's daughter) established the official mother's day to honor her mother and her efforts. Woodrow Wilson signed the holiday into law six years later, making Mother's day a national holiday.
