When selecting your applicant, please consider, and comply with the following:

- Student must have been actively involved on your council for at least two years.
- Student must be active in two other activities in addition to Student Council.
- Student must be a junior at the time of application.
- Student must have attended LASC Senior High Summer Workshop prior to submitting this application.
- Student must have at least a 3.0 GPA.
- Student must be able to speak in front of an audience
- Student and school must be registered for the LASC State Convention.
- Student must be registered at a Louisiana public school.
- The entire signed application must be mailed and emailed to SBESE Coordinator, Paulette Campbell, on or before the November 1st deadline.
- The application packet must be completed exactly as described on the enclosed forms.
- The envelope containing the packet must be **postmarked on or before November 1, 2024.**

THE DEADLINE AND ALL RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

EVERY CANDIDATE FOR THE POSITION OF STUDENT ADVISOR TO THE STATE BOARD OF ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION MUST HAVE THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have been an active member in his or her school's Student Council for at least two years.
- Must be in the 11th grade at the time of application.
- Must have an unweighted minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must be active in 2 activities in addition to Student Council
- Must be of the highest moral and ethical character.
- Must be a registered delegate at the LASC State Convention in January
- Must have previously attended LASC Senior High Summer Workshop
- **Must be articulate and have the ability to work effectively with adults. They must also be well-versed and very informed about all aspects of the State BESE Board before the interview session during the LASC State Convention. The representative must also be able to speak in front of large audiences.**

THE SELECTION PROCEDURE WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

- Each applicant must submit his/her application, as described below, to SBESE Coordinator, Paulette Campbell by both mail (1250 School Street, Hackberry 70645) and email (paulette_campbell@camsch.org) on or before the deadline date stated in the cover letter.
- There can be only one applicant per PUBLIC school.
- The applicants will be invited to appear for an interview before a final selection committee, which will convene at 10:00 am, on the morning of Saturday, January 18th at the convention at Sulphur High School.
- The newly elected student representative and the first alternate will be announced during a General Session at the LASC State Convention.
- Applicants should appear in dress clothing for the interview, presentation on stage Sunday afternoon, and the winner should be in dress clothing for the Monday morning general session.
- The winner should be prepared to attend a state board meeting immediately after the general session the Monday of convention. It will also be mandatory for the winner to attend the LASC Executive Board Meeting in February 2025 in Pineville, LA and the September Board Meeting in August 2025 in Pineville, LA. All meals and student housing for the Executive Board meetings will be provided by LASC.

THE APPLICATION MUST CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING:

1. Completed application
2. Recent photograph
3. 275–300-word essay, prepared by the applicant, on the following topic:
“What suggestions would you make to improve education in our state of Louisiana?”
4. This essay must be typed, using 12-point *Times New Roman* font, and double-spaced.
5. One-page letter of recommendation from the applicant’s advisor or principal
6. One-page letter of recommendation from an individual outside the applicant’s school
7. Leadership Positions/Honors form

Entries are limited to this form only.

Please list club memberships where an office was held FIRST, then those with no offices if space allows.

8. Permission Slip and Reimbursement Agreement

LEADERSHIP ACTIVITIES	15 points
GPA (consideration given to courses taken)	5 points
INTERVIEW	40 points
